Additional Graduation Requirements

- **2.0 Unweighted GPA**
- **Pass Reading FAST ELA (10th grade year) or achieve concordant score**
- **Pass Algebra 1 B.E.S.T. test or achieve concordant score**
- **Take the Geometry B.E.S.T. test - counts as 30% of final grade**
- **Take Biology and US History EOC- counts as 30% of final grade (if course was completed in State of FL public school)**

9th Grade Curriculum Plan

- Students are *strongly encouraged* to complete their Fine Art/Practical Art course requirement by the end of Sophomore year.
- If HOPE is completed online *prior* to the first day of school, the student will be placed in a different elective.
- Students currently enrolled in HOPE online should contact their High School Counselor **BEFORE** July 1.

Accelerated Coursework

- The State of Florida expects all high school students to graduate with at least one accelerated opportunity.
- Every student will be placed into at least one Accelerated Course per year
 - Dual Enrollment (DE)
 - Advanced Placement (AP)
 - Cambridge International
 - Course with an Industry Certification Exam
 - Career Technical Education (CTE) courses
- Students can take more than one type of acceleration at the same time

Diploma Designations

Scholar:

*In addition to meeting the standard high school diploma requirements, a student must

- Earn 1 credit in Algebra 2;
- Pass the Geometry B.E.S.T.;
- Earn 1 credit in statistics or equally rigorous math course;
- Pass Biology 1 EOC;
- Earn 1 credit in chemistry or physics;
- Earn 1 credit in a course equally rigorous to chemistry or physics;
- Pass the US History EOC;
- Earn 2 credits in the same world language;
- Earn at least 1 credit in Advanced Placement (AP), IB, AICE, or Dual Enrollment;
- Takes the respective AP assessment; and earns a minimum score to earn college credit

Merit:

*In addition to meeting the standard high school diploma requirements...

- Attain one or more industry certifications from the list established (per s. 1003.492, F.S.)

Biliteracy:

SILVER -

- Earn 4 world language courses in the same language with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale; or earn a score or performance level on any of the examination that the district offers (AP Exam, SAT Subject test)

GOLD -

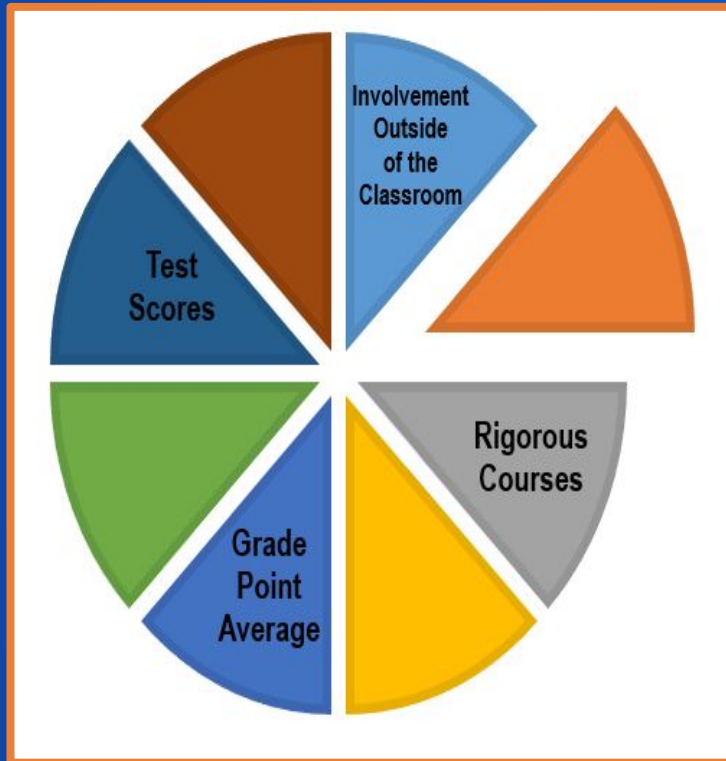
- Earn 4 world language courses in the same language with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale and a Level 4 or higher on the Grade 10 English Language Arts Florida Standards Assessment
- Or earn a score or performance level on any of the examination that the district offers (AP Exam, SAT Subject test)

HOPE Course Requirement

- Middle School Counselor will approve classes while you are still registered in middle school.
- Over summer, student profiles need to be changed to West Orange High School. Otherwise, we cannot verify course completion and final grades cannot be added.
- You must have the class completed by the deadline (Aug 1st) in order to request another elective course on your schedule. Please make sure to contact your WOHS counselor over summer if you are working through the class. You cannot take HOPE online and on campus during the school year.

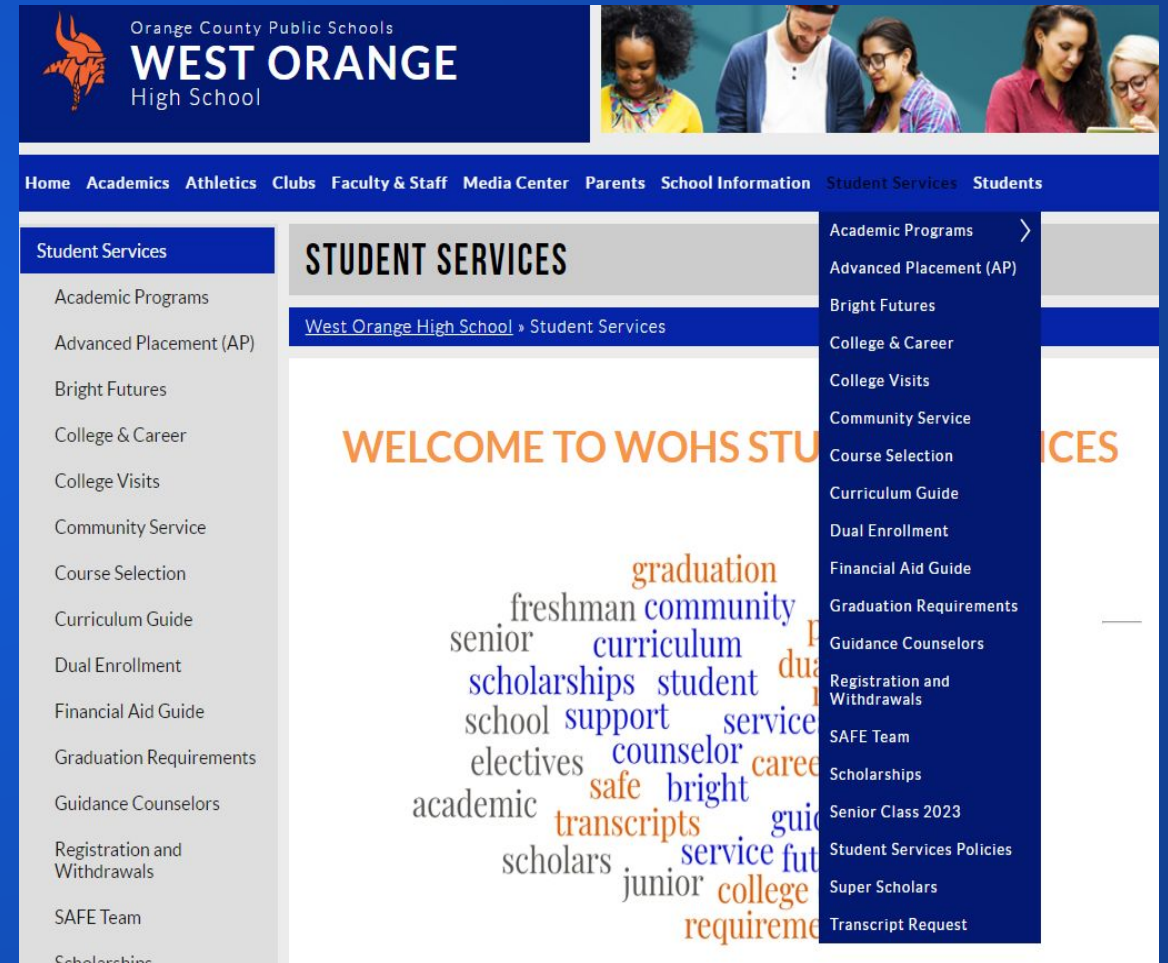
