

Graduation Dress Code

Graduation dress code is per OCPS Guidelines and Protocols. Please be advised this dress code is strictly enforced and any student not in dress code will NOT walk at graduation, no exceptions.

Students wearing a **BLUE** gown:

Males:

- Dark Trousers
- Collared Shirts
- Tie (no string ties)
- Dark Dress Shoes and Socks

Females:

- Dress or Skirt/Slacks & Blouse/Sweater
- Dress Shoes or Sandals

For **NHS** students graduating in **WHITE** gowns:

Males:

- Dark Trousers
- **White, Pale, or Pastel** Collared Shirts
- Tie (no string ties)
- Dark Dress Shoes and Socks

Females:

- **White, Pale, or Pastel** Dress or Skirt/Slacks & **White, Pale, or Pastel** Blouse/Sweater
- Dress Shoes or Sandals

Not Acceptable:

- Students should not write on or decorate cap and gown
- Flowers or additional items should not be carried or pinned to gown
- Sneakers, flip flops, t-shirts, or jeans are not acceptable for males or females
- Cell Phones

Cords: A maximum of **THREE (3)** cords may be worn. No outside medals or cords may be worn.
